### INTROIT

**Ant.** Attende Domine, et miserere, quia peccavimus tibi.

**Ant.** Hear us, O Lord, and have mercy upon us, for we have sinned against thee.

**V.** Ad te, Rex summe, omnium redemptor, oculos nostros sublevamus flentes: exaudi, Christe, supplicatum preces.

**V.** To thee, O highest King, redeemer of all, weeping we raise our eyes: hear, O Christ, the prayers of those who call upon thee.

**V.** Dextera Patris, lapis angularis, via salutis, ianua caelestis, abluere nostri maculas delicti.

**V.** O right hand of the Father, O cornerstone, O Way of salvation and Gate of Heaven: cleanse away the stains of our sins.

**V.** Rogamus, Deus, tuam maiestatem: auribus sacris gemitus exaudi: crimina nostra placidus indulge.

**V.** O God, we beseech thy majesty: with thy holy ears hear our groaning: gently forgive our offenses.

**V.** Tibi fatemur crimina admissa: contrito corde pandimus occulta: tua, Redemptor, pietas ignoscat.

**V.** To thee we make known our offenses: we reveal all that is hidden with a contrite heart: may thy kindness, O Redeemer, forgive us.

**V.** Innocens captus, nec repugnans ductus; testibus falsis pro impiis damnatus: quos redemisti, tu conserva, Christe.

**V.** The blameless one was seized, yet refused not to be led, condemned by false witnesses for the sake of wicked men: O Christ, save those whom thou hast re-deemed.
