### INTROIT

**Ant.** Iudica me, Deus, et discerne causam meam de gente non sancta: ab homine iniquo et doloso eripe me: quia tu es Deus meus, et fortitudo mea.

*Ant.* Judge me, O God, and distinguish my cause from the nation that is not holy: from the deceitful and impious man rescue me: for thou art my God, and my strength.
