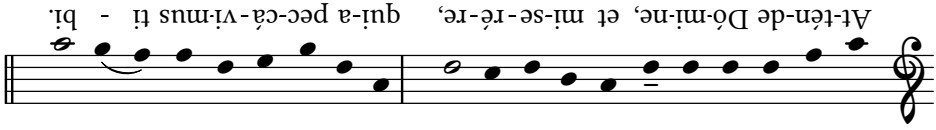


SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

V. To thee, O highest King, redeemer of all, weeping we raise our eyes: O Christ, hear the prayers of those who call upon thee.

V. Ad te, Rex summe, omnium redemptor, oculos nostros sublevámus flentes: exaudi, Christe, supplicántium preces.

V. O right hand of the Father, O cornerstone, O Way of salvation and Gate of Heaven: wipe away the stains of our sins.

V. Dextera Patris, lapis angularis, via salutis, iánua cælestis, abluere nostri máculas delicti.

V. O God, we beseech thy majesty: with thy holy ears hear our groaning: gently forgive our offenses.

in this our fast of forty days.*

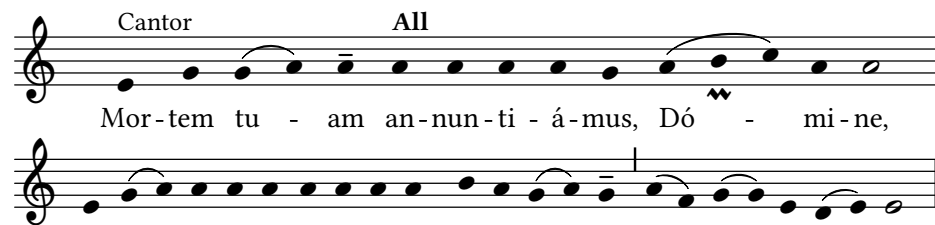

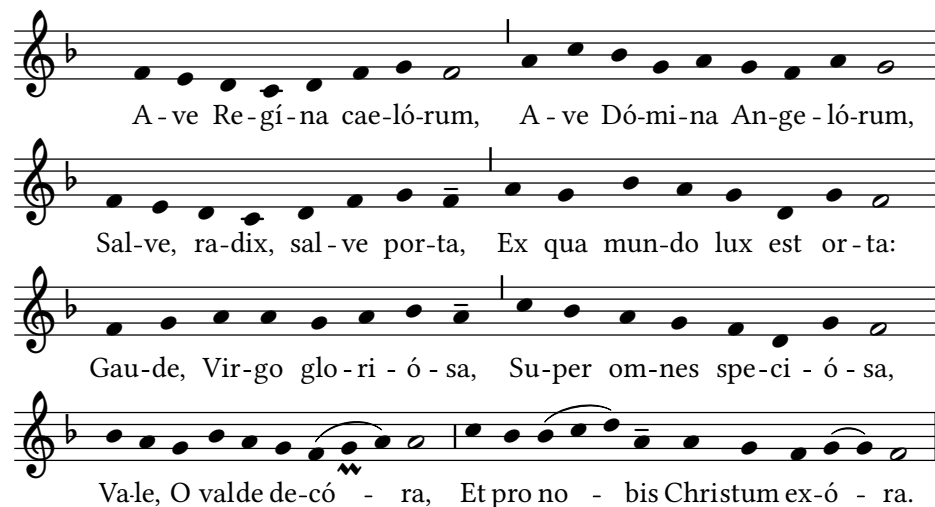
